As chairs of the Senate Environment and Energy and House Energy Committees, we would like to express our support for the letter sent to you by the Secretary of the Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control on April 14. In this letter, Secretary Garvin requests the Special Initiative on Offshore Wind (SIOW) conduct a study of potential power solicitation, and options for such a procurement. We join him in encouraging the conduction of this study. Secretary Garvin adds that DNREC would like to "take a deeper look" at the current offshore wind market, and that "DNREC would like to take advantage of the expertise and market insight that the SIOW can provide."
